FRIENDS AT THE END

We believe that medically assisted dying should be available to all mentally competent adults with either a terminal illness or an incurable condition causing hopeless and unbearable suffering with no reasonable alternative to relieve it, provided this is their own persistent request.

CURRENT LAW IN SCOTLAND

- No legislation assume it is illegal. Regarded as deliberate killing = murder/ culpable homicide charge
- No guidelines from the Lord Advocate (Eng & Wales have this from DPP)
- Minimal and confusing case law Gordon Ross: 'It is not a crime to assist another to commit suicide...nor to take a person to a place where they will'

LAW REFORM IN SCOTLAND

- End of Life Assistance Bill 2010. "become intolerable through a progressive degenerative condition, a trauma or a terminal illness to seek a doctor's help in dying.
- Assisted Suicide (Scotland) Bill 2013. "terminal, progressive or life-shortening illnesses to obtain assistance in ending their own life by suicide.
 - Advocated 3 stage process:
 - Preliminary Declaration,
 - First Request for Assistance,
 - Second Request for Assistance.
